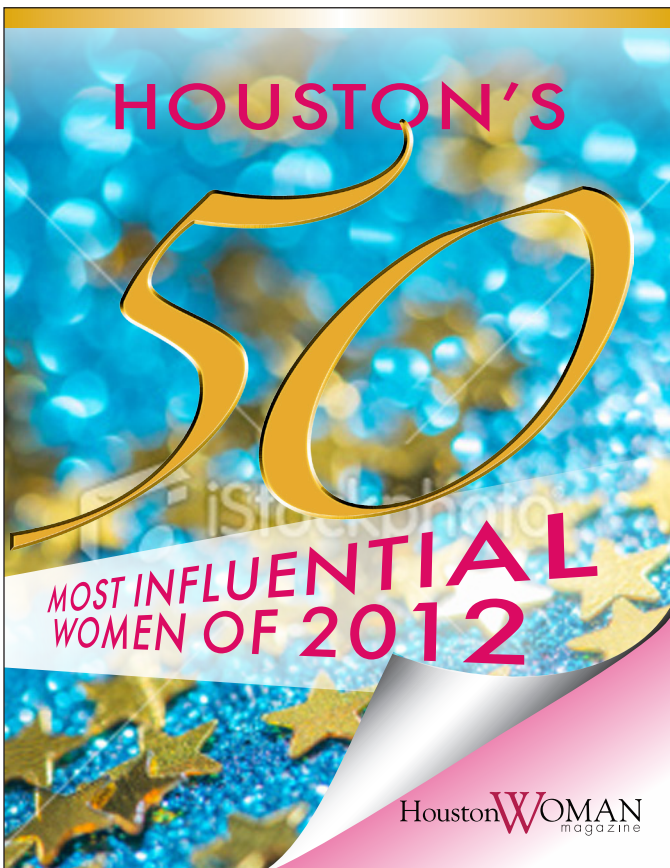

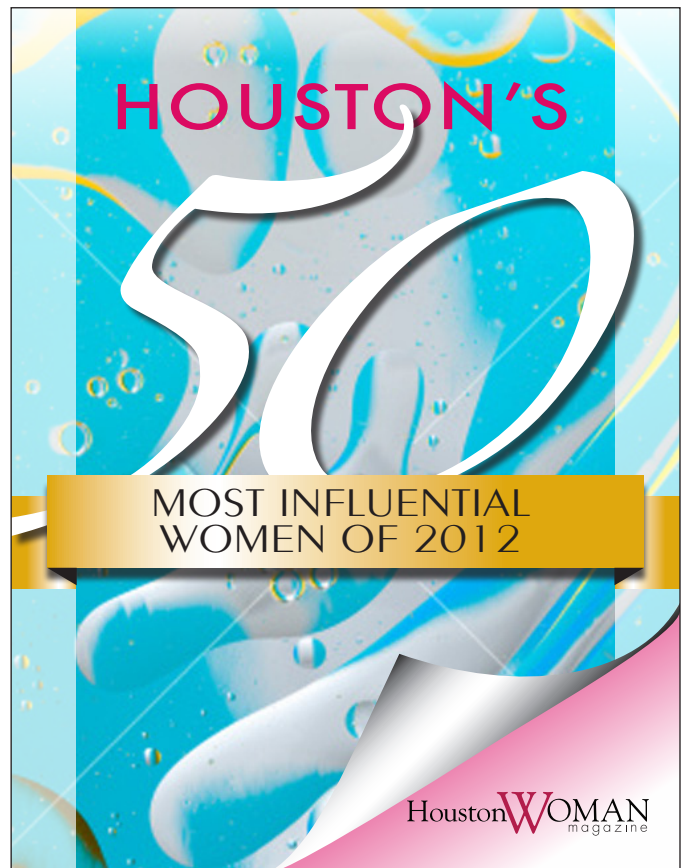

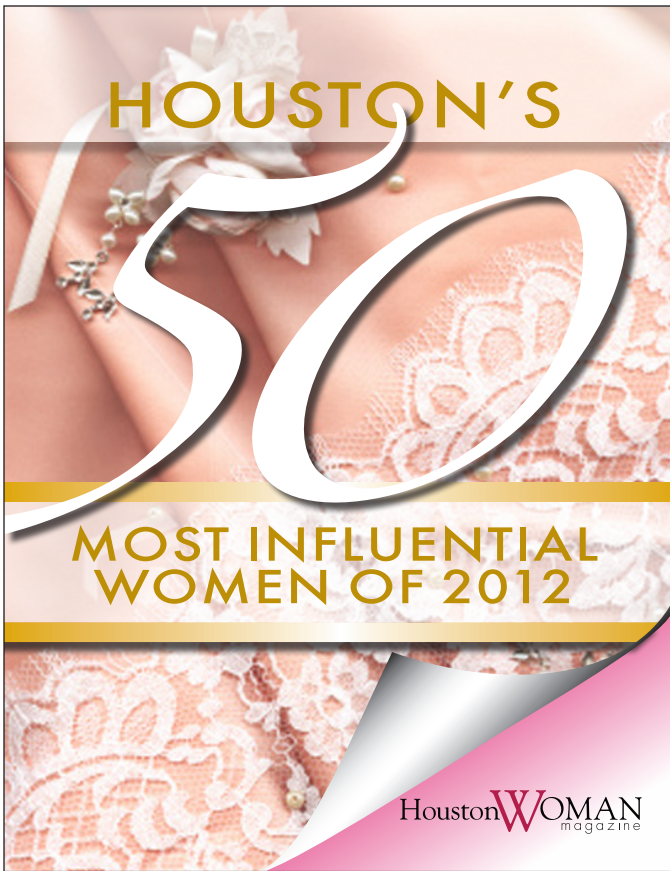

Vicki has served locally on the United Way Board of Directors, Montgomery County Emergency Assistance Board, Montgomery County AHA Board, Junior Achievement Founding Committee, and the RE/MAX CMNH Golf Tournament Committee.
