

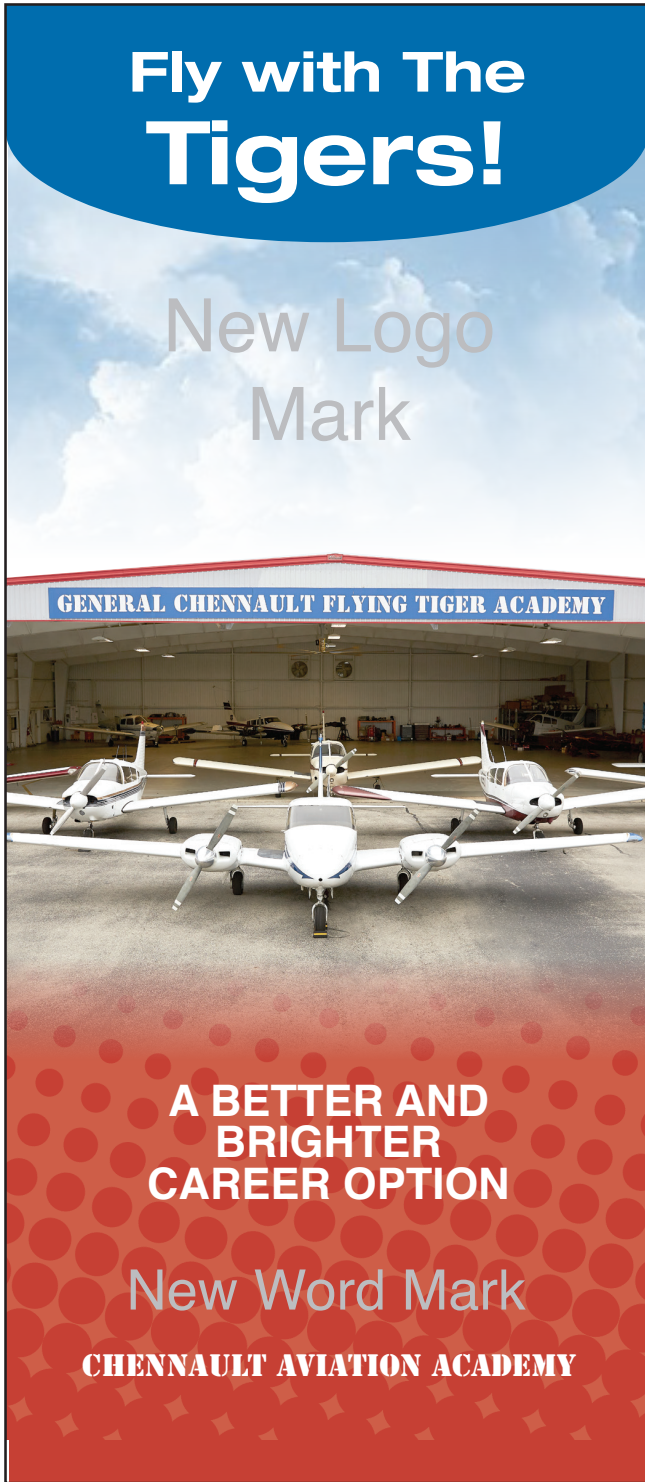

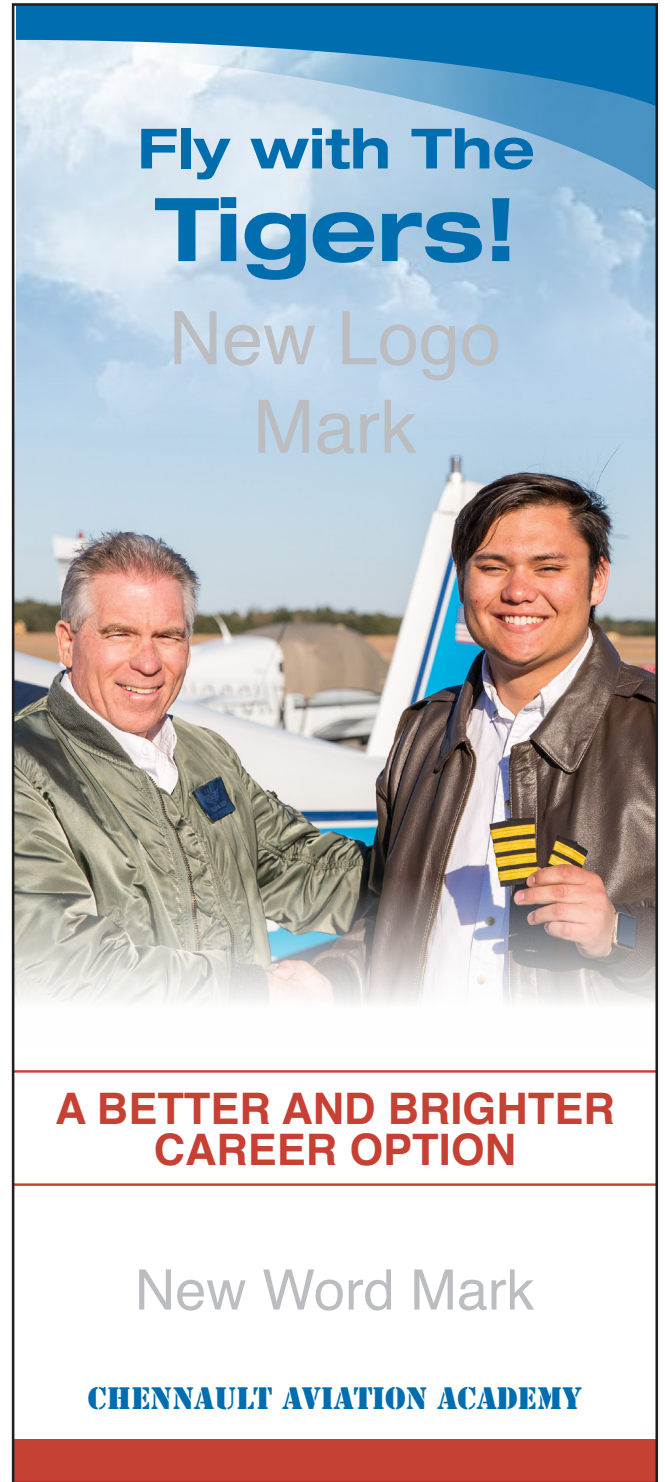

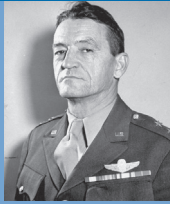

## Professional Pilot Programs

Professional Pilot Program is designed to take a full-time trainee from zero flight time to 300 flight hours with the licenses and ratings needed to pursue your aviation career.

## Individual Courses

Individual Courses are designed for students who are looking to get an additional rating, gain flight hours or would like to learn on a part-time basis. All of our full-time student qualifications are available to part-time students

## Professional Pilot Plus Degree

In 3 Years, students gain a bachelor of science degree at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU), take Professional Pilot Program with CAA to obtain PPL/IR/CPL/CFI, and obtain 1,500 flight hours.

### THE FIRST YEAR:

- 5 Semesters, 9 Weeks Long, 6 Credit Hours per Semester with ERAU (30 credits total);
- Plus 30 College Credit Hours for Your Pilot Licenses When You Finish CAA Professional Pilot Program;
- Earn 60 College Credit Hours and an Associate of Science in Aeronautics, and 300 Flight Hours.

### THE SECOND YEAR:

- 30 More College Credits with ERAU;
- Start Working as a CFI and Building Flight Hours;
- Complete Year Two with 90 College Credits and 900 Flight Hours.

### THE THIRD YEAR:

- 30 More College Credits with ERAU;
- Continue Working as a CFI and Building Flight Hours;
- Complete Year Three with 120 College Credits and a Bachelor of Science in Aeronautics;
- Accumulate to 1,500 Flight Hours and Secure Your Regional Airline Pilot Job.
