September 2, 2017(Nautical Mile)

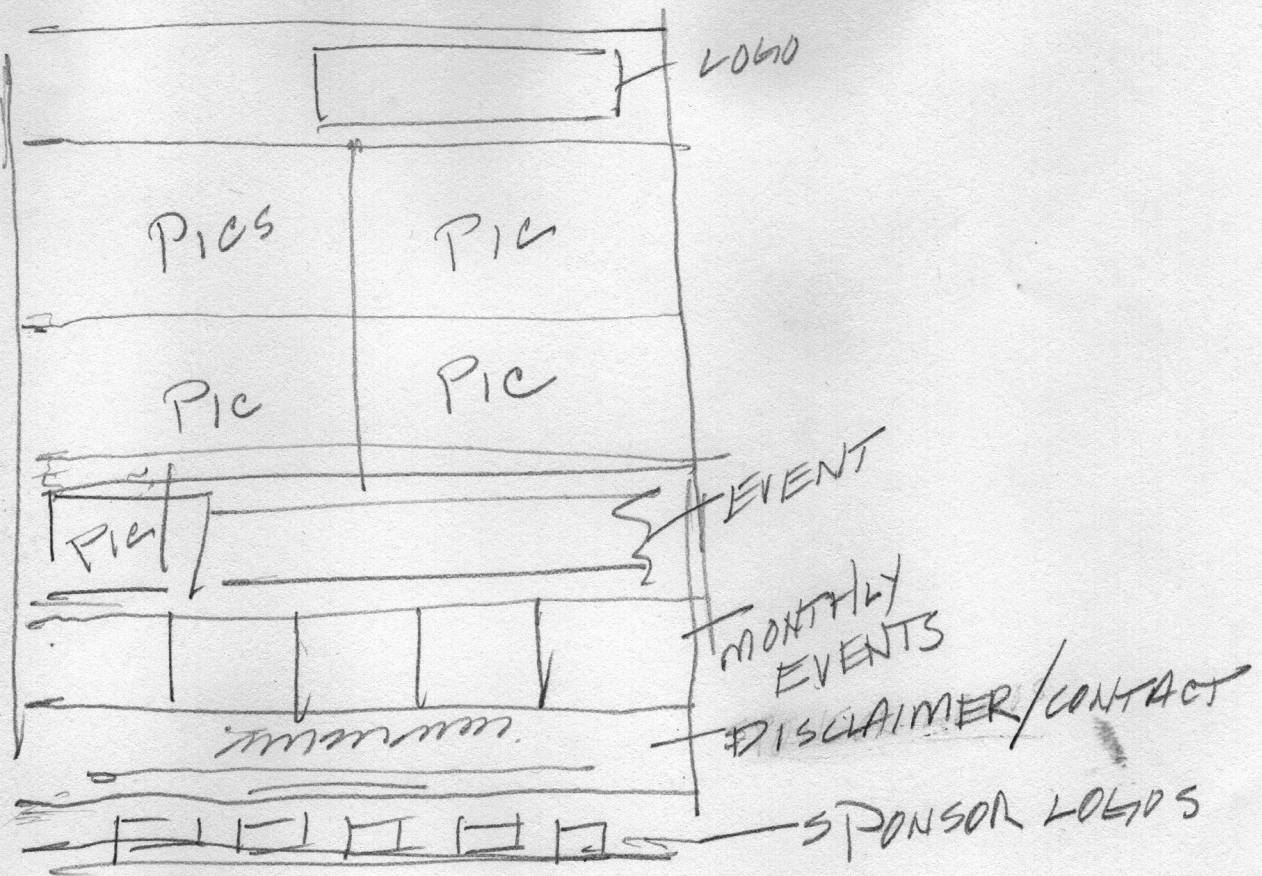
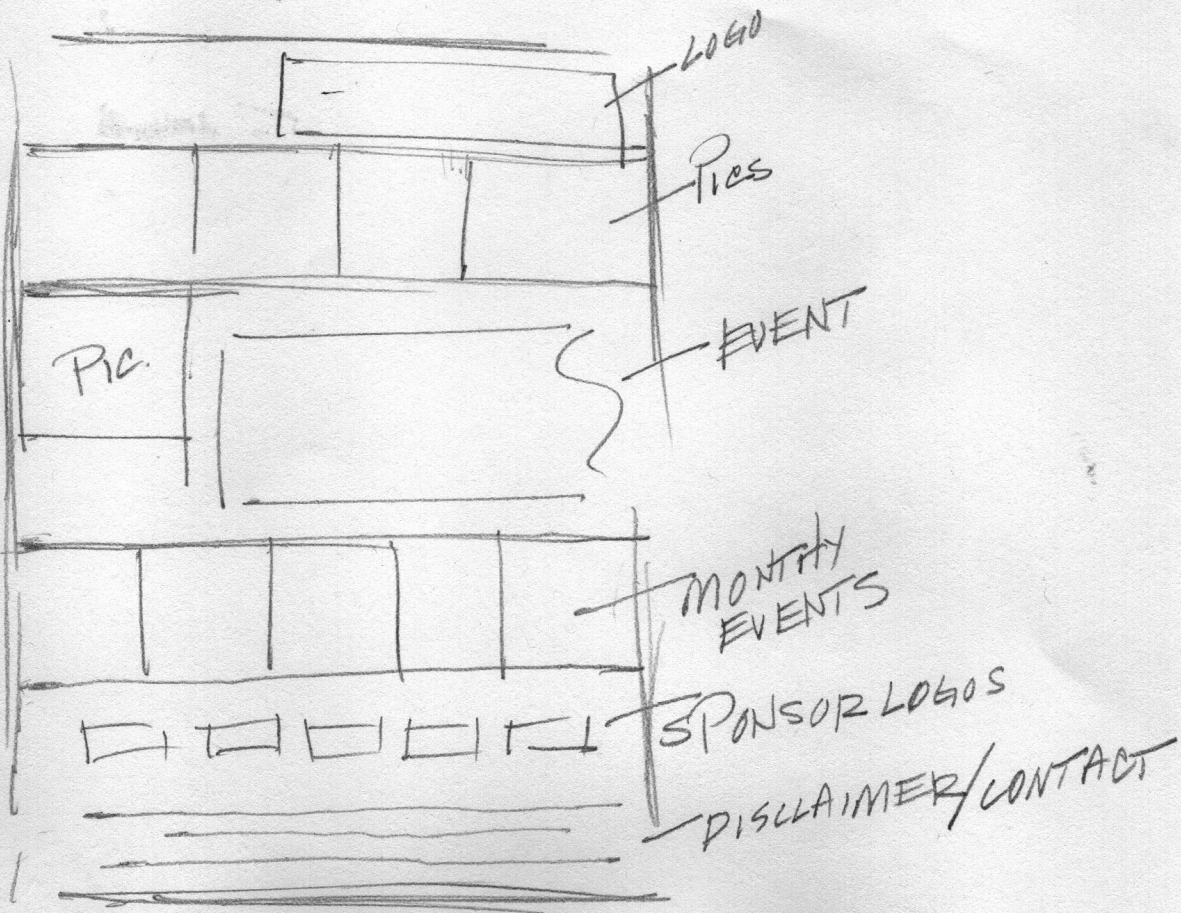

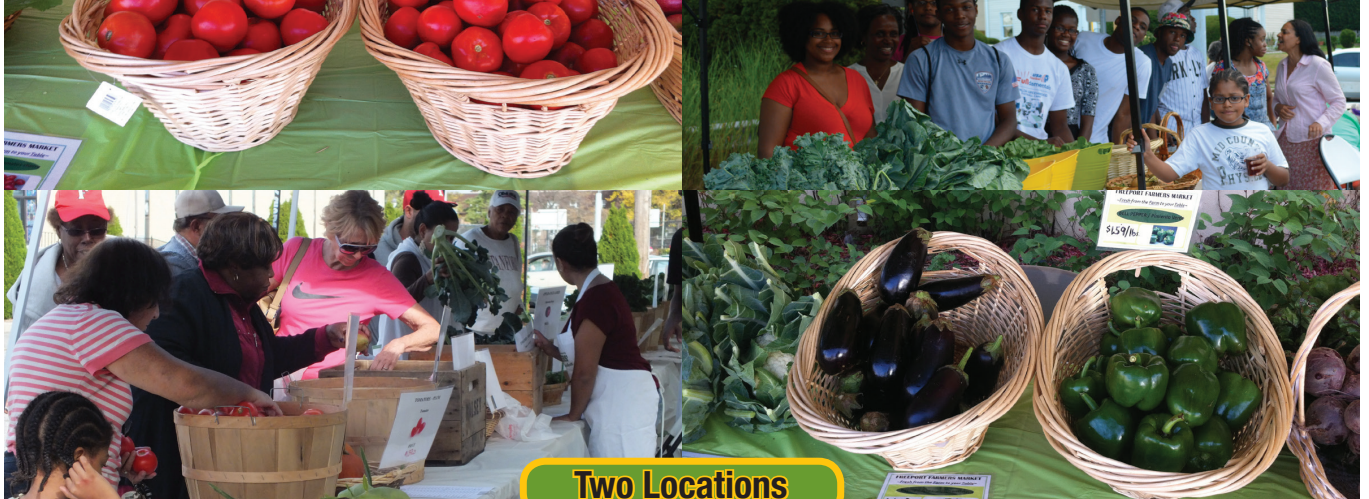
